How to Enter:

Size: Your picture should be on an A4 size piece of paper or card. (Your teacher can tell you what this is.)

Materials: You can use your choice of: crayons, pens, paints and/or collage.

Introduce yourself: make your name/age/school stand out in your picture; or include them within the picture (a banana? chocolate bar wrapper? a sign or a flag?)

Deadline: The closing date for the Fairtrade Fortnight Art Competition is: 26-02-2021
